Transportation

Complimentary Shuttle Bus To Edgartown From Winnetu:

Our shuttle service is offered To and From Edgartown. Daily Drop Off to Edgartown: 8:15a.m.; 11:00 a.m.; 2:15p.m.; 4:00 p.m.; and 7:15 p.m. from the Garden Pavilion.

Please Note: All shuttle trips are dependent demand; therefore, we do not automatically operate our shuttle on the scheduled times. Please make arrangement with the Front Desk for any drop-offs or returns from Edgartown.

Vineyard Bus Service (VTA):

The VTA operates bus service to and from Edgartown, Oak Bluffs, Vineyard Haven, Menemsha and Up Island. VTA buses leave the Winnetu from the end of Dunes Road, across the street in front of "F Building" Townhouses or from the Mattakesett Activities Center at Pinkletinks Café. Buses depart every half hour between 8:45 a.m. and 6:15 p.m. Complete shuttle schedules are available from the Garden Pavilion, Front Desk, or Mattakesett Activities Center.

Taxi Service:

Taxis are plentiful and easy to use. The current fare to Edgartown is \$10 for the first 2 people and then \$3 for each additional person. Call the Reception Desk at (508) 627-4747 to request a taxi. Fares subject to change.
